## THRIFTY TOWER CONSIGNMENT RULES

## **Sponsored by Bavaria Community and Spouses Club**

- A maximum of 18 items per day are accepted. Eight items may be clothing, one (1) pair of shoes per week and one (1) handbag per week.
- 2. Items with multiple pieces must be placed in zip-top baggies, cables and wires must be tied and secured.
- 3. The Thrift Shop will keep 25% of each consigned item sold.
- 4. THERE IS A 10% WITHDRAWAL FEE ON EACH ITEM YOU WANT TO REMOVE BEFORE YOUR EXPIRATION DATE. The total of the withdrawal transaction may not exceed \$10. Items withdrawn may not be re-consigned for 6 months. The Thrift Shop Staff does not notify individuals of items expiring. It is your responsibility to check on your items.
- 5. All items have a consignment period of 45 calendar days, regardless of price. If the expiration date falls on a holiday or on a day the Thrift Shop is closed, it is your responsibility to come in **BEFORE** items expire. On the 46th day, the merchandise becomes Thrift Shop Property (TSP).
- 6. Holiday items may only be consigned during the appropriate season to which it corresponds. Holiday items expire on the holiday they correspond with or the last business day before the holiday. Consignors may withdraw holiday items on the last business day without paying a withdrawal fee. Any items left becomes TSP.
- 7. All articles of clothing must be clean and undamaged. All snaps, buttons, buckles, and zippers must be in working order. Items that are not acceptable will be discarded.
- 8. All electrical items must be clean and in operating order. No exposed or taped wires. All electrical items must be tested by Thrift Shop staff before being accepted, items that are not acceptable will be discarded.
- 9. Consignments will be taken during business hours. Days and hours are subject to change.
- 10. No clothing will be taken during the months of March and August. (Manager's discretion)
- 11. Large or bulk items must be pre-approved, space permitting. Please call before bringing in your item.
- 12. **Items may not be consigned for less than \$1** with additional increases in increments of \$.50. (You may mark down your items before the expiration date, but that does not extend the expiration date.)
- 13. Items not acceptable for consignment: no military issued items, washers, dryers, stoves, pieces to satellite dishes, firearms, flammable items, tires, used gas cans, car parts, used undergarments or swimwear. (Terms are subject to change, consult manager/consignment clerk)

14. The Thrift Shop reserves the right to limit/change the amount or types of items consigned at any given time, and to modify the conditions of this agreement at any time.
